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Center for LNG Welcomes House Passage of H.R. 4606, the “Ensuring Small Scale LNG Certainty and Access Act”

(Washington, D.C.) – In response to the passage of H.R. 4606, the “Ensuring Small Scale LNG Certainty and Access Act,” Center for Liquefied Natural Gas (CLNG) Executive Director Charlie Riedl issued the following statement:

“We welcome the House’s passage of H.R. 4606 and the certainty it provides for smaller scale LNG projects. This legislation reduces hurdles, streamlines the process and allows for the U.S. LNG industry to compete in a global and fast growing market.

“This legislation will allow small scale U.S. LNG exports to better supply markets in the Caribbean and Latin America, benefit our citizens in Puerto Rico, and improve our competitive position in local LNG markets.

“We applaud the House and recognize the tireless efforts of Rep. Bill Johnson (R-Ohio) in support of regulatory certainty for U.S. LNG. Passage of this bill in the House and hopefully in the Senate will help position U.S. LNG as a global and flexible supplier, all while providing good paying jobs at home and reducing pollution and emissions abroad.”
